Trench Lock

A motion was recently tabled by Cllr Jasmine Bennett at the Full Council meeting in January, which was approved by H&LPC. The motion seeks to request that Telford & Wrekin Council considers opening the taxi and bus lane near to KFC to all traffic, allowing vehicles from Hadley to turn right on to the EP, and easing congestion on the Hortonwood section of the interchange. We will update on this once we have a response.


We need your help with our Council Logo...

Update from Hadley & Leegomery Borough ward Members...

It has only been a few months since the election, but we have been out and about across the ward - carrying out two Ward Walks a week, on Tuesdays and Sundays at 10am. We report any issues like potholes or surface issues, overgrowing weeds and overflowing bins. There are also a number of larger projects that we have been working on including a road safety scheme on Hadley Park Road, and major footpath works around the Leegomery area, footpaths around Leegomery Community Centre and replacement of the crossing near Millbrook Primary (which has now been completed). We have also hopefully identified funding for the road to Hadley Community Centre and Castle Lane. We have lots more to do, so we will keep you updated on our work across Hadley & Leegomery. We are always out and about speaking to residents, and we also hold regular monthly surgeries on the first Saturday of each month (except August).

Marlborough Road, Trench Lock

Cllr Eileen Callear has once again raised the issue of traffic on Marlborough Road, in Trench Lock ward. This was first raised by Cllr Callear in June 2019, and she has had a number of meetings with Borough Members, Highways Officers and is still working hard to try to get a solution to the issues, to help improve the situation for residents. Parking is a major issue, and the road is regularly blocked up with disputes over priority and parking. We are once again going to raise this with Telford & Wrekin Borough Members, and Highways to try to get a solution to this problem. This could be changing the layout or installing double yellows in certain areas. If you have any thoughts on this, please do get in touch with Cllr Callear.

On a separate note, Cllr Callear has been asked to set up a **NEW NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME** for the area (including Marlborough Road and the roads surrounding) and would love to hear from you if you would like to join the scheme, or have any suggestions!

Spotlight on...

Horton and Hortonwood

After a long-drawn-out consultation on a decision to reopen Horton Lane, and following successful campaigning by the Horton Community Group, the Borough Council decided in early December that the Permanent Traffic Regulation Order remains in place with no further changes made to Horton Lane. To support this recommendation, and to mitigate concerns relating to increase traffic on the Humber Lane to Leegomery Roundabout route, improvements will be made to this route which will include traffic calming measures, reduced speed limits and a full review of all signing and lining throughout the route. The aim will be to deliver these improvements by Autumn 2024.

Redsun Park (Telford) is a proposed new build industrial development located in the thriving Hortonwood Industrial Estate. Redsun Projects Ltd secured planning in 2022 for 350,000sqft of industrial space split across 4 units. In November 2023 Redsun sold the site with planning permission to Total Developments North West who are based in Chester and the project is to be renamed as Total Park. Work has now commenced on this development and it is expected that the first two buildings will be completed by January 2025. The complete project is probably going to be finished in early 2026. A start date has not yet been given by Total Developments. Redsun will continue with other projects in Telford and Wrekin including Pioneer Park based in Halesfield.

The development of the land to the East of Melitta (Cofresco) by Morris Property will be the construction of 2 large warehouse units. Construction on the first warehouse commenced in January 2024 with all the steelwork likely to be in place by April and the first phase finished by the end of 2024. The local Horton Community Group arranged a useful on-site briefing for local residents on 4th January 2024 to gain a better insight into the extent of the build.

Our Borough and Parish Councillors are hoping to hold training and information sessions, to assist and show residents how to use the app, and to help with any queries that come up.


